

DIRECTIONS TO THE ISLE OF SKYE FROM GLASGOW



- Follow the **M73** and **join the M8 North**
- Take the **M8 over the Erskine Bridge** and join the **A82 North**
- Follow the **A82 up Loch Lomond side** and at **Tarbert veer right**, staying on the **A82 for Crianlarich**
- **At Crianlarich turn left heading north following the A82 for Tyndrum and Fort William**
- **At Tyndrum stay on the A82 North to Fort William** (you will pass Bridge of Orchy, through Glenceo, Ballachullish, Onich to Fort William)
- At Fort William continue on the **A82 north to Spean Bridge**
- Continue **on the A82 north to Invergarry**
- At Invergarry take the **A87 north to Kyle of Lochalsh / Skye Bridge** (through Cluanie, Shiel bridge, Inverinate, Dornie, Balmacara)
- Cross the Skye Bridge (open all day/night)
- Take the **A850 north towards Portree** (passing through Broadford, Luib, Sconser) to Sligichan.
- **At Sligichan continue on the A850 to Portree**
- **At Portree take the A850 north to Borve**
- **At Borve veer left on the A850 towards Dunvegan**
- Follow the **signs towards Dunvegan (but not to Dunvegan)** passing Skeabost, Treaslane, Kildonan, Flashadder,,Edinbane)
- From Edinbane you continue up the hill, and down the other side, after about **2-3 miles you will see a turning on your right hand side signposted B886 to Waternish, turn right.**
- Follow that road all the way to a 'T Junction' where you turn left down towards the loch side sign posted Stein. We are the last building on the right hand side on the shore as you come down to the village.
